Pros: 1. Simple non-invasive at-home stool collection widely advertised on TV.

2. Good at excluding colon cancer. If results are normal, 92% chance that you do not have colon cancer.

Cons: 1. Not designed to *prevent* colon cancer. Cologuard looks for colon cancer DNA in stool AFTER you get cancer. We have had a very accurate test to prevent colon cancer for 50 years - screening colonoscopy. Find and remove a polyp... prevent a cancer. Cologuard is *not* a test to find colon polyps before they turn to cancer. By the time this test is abnormal, you may already have a cancer that could have been prevented. It may be too late for cure even with surgery and chemo.

2. Less sensitive for cancer than high quality colonoscopy.

3. High false positive rate. Most of the patients we have seen with abnormal Cologuard do *not* have cancer. False positive rate increases with patient age. Test includes a non-specific stool FIT test for blood in stool, but they will not report this separately. Most of the sensitivity of this test comes from the FIT test which is a fraction of the cost.

4. Only for average risk individuals. Not approved or covered for those who have already had colon polyps or have a family history of colon cancer or polyps.

5. If your Cologuard test is abnormal, you will still need to have a colonoscopy. But, now your health insurance will consider this to be a DIAGNOSTIC colonoscopy not a SCREENING colonoscopy. You may have to pay the full deductible and copay for colonoscopy

6. **\$500 dollar stool test** - most insurance plans cover but someone is paying for this. We all are.
